THE LOUISIANA CHILDREN'S MUSEUM EXPLORES THE SCIENCE OF LEMONS ON FETCH! LEMONADE DAY - SATURDAY, APRIL 30

New Orleans, LA– The Louisiana Children's Museum (LCM) will explore the science of lemons on **Fetch! Lemonade Day, Saturday, April 30** from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The LCM Fetch! exhibit is based on the popular kids' reality show on PBS called Fetch! The show sends kids out into the real world to test their wits with interesting challenges, prompting them to conduct experiments and investigate the world around them. Now kids can experience this engaging approach to science right here at LCM. The exhibit, ideal for ages six to ten, gives kids the opportunity to participate in Fetch!-style activities whenever they come to the Museum.

Visitors can:

- Learn how to convert cups to gallons in the Museum Atrium on the first floor
- Participate in an experiment using a lemon battery in the Fetch! exhibit on the first floor
- Compare liquids to identify sweet vs sour in the Kids Café exhibit on the second floor
- Learn how lemons are grown and add your own lemon to our collaborative lemon tree in the Museum Atrium on the first floor
- Use a lemon juice mixture to compose a secret message to a friend in the Museum Atrium on the first floor
- Make a sign for your own lemonade stand in Art Trek on the second floor
- Enjoy a special lemon themed Storytime in the Times-Picayune Theatre at noon and 2 p.m. on the first floor
- Participate in lemonade tastings to help determine the winner of LCM's Best Tasting Lemonade Contest. The winner will be announced at 2:30 p.m. and a prize will be awarded.

The Louisiana Children's Museum is also a designated Lemonade Day registration station. Lemonade Day of South Louisiana is a FREE, community wide program that promotes entrepreneurship and character development among South Louisiana's youth by supporting them in establishing and operating their own lemonade business on Saturday, May 7. The Museum will serve as a registration station where children may pick up materials to help them plan and execute their own lemonade stand.
