WHAT: During the 11th annual Fetch! Super Science Saturday, kids can interact with knowledgeable geologists and become junior paleontologists, participating in a wide variety of fun, hands-on, table-top activities while learning about geology and oil exploration. - **Dig for dinosaur bones in our dinosaur sand box**

- **Calculate whether or not a dinosaur could fit in the tallest building in New Orleans in our *New Orleans: Proud to Call It Home* Architecture Exhibit on the Museum's second floor**
